

Mar Thoma College, Tiruvalla established in the year 1952, has completed an illustrious period of seventy years in the field of higher education. The beginning of the College was very humble with just 250 students and twelve faculty members and over the years owing to the dedicated efforts of the staff and the Management the College has become a premier centre of learning in the State and in the Country. Having obtained the unique distinction of being one of the first accredited Colleges in India and the first in Kerala, the College has also been credited with the honour of being one among the first 22 Colleges in India to be re-accredited in the fourth cycle of accreditation by NAAC. The College has earned commendable achievements including obtaining the 80th position in All India NIRF 2021ranking and ISO 9001:2015 certification. At this moment of pride and glory, we gratefully acknowledge and appreciate the pain and tears of our founding fathers particularly that of His Grace the Most Rev. Dr. Juhanon Mar Thoma Metropolitan, Rt. Rev. Dr Mathews Mar Athanasius Episcopa and Sri. K. K Kuruvilla. During this period nearly eighty thousand students have gone out of the portals of this institution to find a meaningful life in the world. The College, guided by the Grace of God Almighty, and our eminent leadership and strengthened by the aspirations of many generations, is gearing up in the context of New Educational Policy 2020.

The College is in its 70th year of inception and has been celebrating its Sapthathi through various programmes, under seven major heads. When the activities of the Sapthathi celebrations began, the Manager of the College was His Lordship Rt. Rev. Dr. Euyakim Mar Coorilos Suffragan Metropolitan. His Lordship Rt. Rev. Thomas Mar Timotheos Episcopa was assumed the Manager of the College on 1st March 2022.

1. COURSES OFFERED

The College offers twelve Undergraduate (BA/BSc/B. Com) programmes, eleven Post-graduate (MA/MSc) Programmes and seven Doctoral Degree programmes. The MSc programmes in Microbiology and Biotechnology are offered under self-financing streams. Out of fifteen Departments of the College, seven Departments are accredited Research Centres of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. In addition to the UG, PG programmes and Certificate Courses, the College offers eighteen Supplementary Enrichment Programmes in various areas.

2. AWARDS/RECOGNITIONS TO THE INSTITUTION

The college has been ranked in the 80th position in All India NIRF Ranking 2021. The college was positioned in 9th under the head "Best Value for Money by India Today Ranking in 2021. The college has been presented with Vanamitra Award from the Kerala Government, instituted by the Kerala Wild Forest Department.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College is functioning well under the co-ordinator Dr Susan Thomas, Department of English. Prof. K. M. Vishnu Namboodiri, Dept. of History and DrNebu John, Department of Chemistry are serving as the joint coordinators of IQAC. Dr. Nebu John is also serving as the SAAC co-ordinator of the College. The IQAC is giving training to the faculty members and office staff of the college in different matters. In the beginning of the academic year, plan of action of the College is prepared by the IQAC and will be implemented through the department activities, subject associations, clubs, and committees. IQAC monitors supplementary programmes, Academic Curriculum Delivery Monitoring, Remedial Programmes, Bridge Courses, Feedback etc. The activities of the IQAC have been monitored through departmental co-ordinators and Criteria Convenors. The IQAC conducts an academic audit of all the departments and reviews the overall progress of the College. The IQAC has a separate office and staff to manage the day-to-day affairs. Thus, the IQAC has been functioning as the centre for all the academic initiatives and quality management measures of the college.

The year 2021-22 witnessed a hybrid mode of learning, with online and offline classes, and hence number of important strategies had to be evolved regarding the conduct of classes, completion of syllabus, conduct of internal assessment tests and seminars, record of online classes taken, conduct of orientation, induction programmes and capacity building programmes. Regular meetings of the IQAC were held and all the major decisions were recorded in the minutes. The College participated in the AISHE (All India Survey on Higher Education) data collection survey process in this year and uploaded the required dataon portal by NIC, Gov of India. The AQAR for the year2020-2021 is under preparation and will be submitted within the stipulated time. Preparations are also underway to shift to an automated ERP software for academic management (Online TCS). In spite of the constraints owing to the pandemic, the following programmes were conducted by the IQAC during this academic year:

1. Academic Plan

The Academic year plan was prepared by the IQAC in its meeting held on 9th August,2021. The Departments were asked to conduct seminars/webinars, give more importance to research work, devise methods to make online learning more effective and submit weekly reports of online classes taken.
