

# ANNUAL REPORT 2022-'23

Mar Thoma College, Tiruvalla established in the year 1952, has completed an illustrious period of seventy one years in the field of higher education. The beginning of the College was very humble with just 250 students and twelve faculty members and over the years owing to the dedicated efforts of the staff and the Management the College has become a premier centre of learning in the State and in the Country. Having obtained the unique distinction of being one of the first accredited Colleges in India and the first in Kerala, the College has also been credited with the honour of being one among the first 22 Colleges in India to be re-accredited in the fourth cycle of accreditation by NAAC. The College has earned commendable achievements including obtaining the 80<sup>th</sup> position in All India NIRF 2021ranking and ISO 9001:2015 certification. The college was positioned in 9<sup>th</sup> under the head "Best Value for Money by India Today Ranking in 2021. At this moment of pride and glory, we gratefully acknowledge and appreciate the pain and tears of our founding fathers particularly that of His Grace the Most Rev. Dr. Juhanon Mar Thoma Metropolitan, Rt. Rev. Dr Mathews Mar Athanasius Episcopa and Sri. K. K Kuruvilla. #### 1. COURSES OFFERED

The College offers twelve Undergraduate (BA/BSc/B. Com) programmes, eleven Postgraduate (MA/MSc) Programmes and seven Doctoral Degree programmes. The MSc programmes in Microbiology and Biotechnology are offered under self-financing streams. Out of sixtenn Departments of the College, seven Departments are accredited Research Centres of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. In addition to the UG, PG programmes and Certificate Courses, the College offers twenty five Supplementary Enrichment Programmes in various areas.

# 14. IQAC

The IQAC of the college has been functioning actively and providing meaningful interventions to maintain quality in the academic and administrative activities of the college. As providing quality education, adopting innovative teaching-learning methods, and assessing them is a continuous process, IQAC in association with the various stakeholders, works to make the teaching-learning journey in the institution, a meaningful one.

This year the IQAC team led by Dr Susan Thomas as coordinator has been striving to help the Management and faculty members of the college in the creation of a learner-centric environment, conducive for quality education. The IQAC meets regularly and the decisions taken are recorded. The *Plan of Action* was chalked out at the onset of the academic year and quality improvement measures were discussed. The IQAC issues *Teachers' Diary* and *Mentoring Register* to all the individual teachers to record the daily teaching and mentoring activities. The *Teachers' Work Summary* is collected annually to document the teaching, research and administrative work taken up by the teacher.

The Departments are provided with Remedial Programme register, Curriculum Delivery Monitoring register, Students' Progression Register to record the concerned details. Feedback is collected and analyzed and regular audits are conducted in the departments. The necessary data for AISHE, NIRF ranking are filed and AQAR is submitted to the NAAC regularly. Apart from these regular activities, the IQAC conducted the following programmes this year:

#### a) Summer Research Internship Programme (SRIP) 2022

The IQAC of the College organized a Summer Research Internship programme for Higher Secondary students from May 25<sup>th</sup> 2022 to June 24<sup>th</sup> 2022. The faculty members of the college known for their outstanding research contributions hosted selected students in their research labs for a month. The Departments of Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Physics, Chemistry, Bio-Science, and Computer Applications offered internships.

#### b) TRAINING SESSION FOR ERPS

A training session in ERPS LINWAYS was organized on 13-09-2022 from 10.30 am to 12.30pm in the Media Centre of the College. Mr Kannan was the resource person. The members of the IQAC, the Principal of the college and the college treasurer Dr George Mathew participated in the programme.

A one-day workshop was conducted on '*Outcome Based Education*' in theMedia Center of the College on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022 from 9.30 am to 3.30 pm. The Centre has already tied up with International Institute for Certification and Training (IICT), an approved training centre based in Kerala.
